PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS: BEFORE YOUR EPIDURAL STEROID INJECTION

Procedure Preparation

- You MUST bring a driver
- Do NOT eat 4 hours prior, clear liquids only. *Clear liquids include: water, tea, coffee (no cream), jello (no fruit)*
- Diabetics, please be sure to discuss taking your diabetic medication with our nurse prior to your appointment.

If you answer yes to any of the following questions, please call 252-752-5000 prior to your appointment and ask to speak with a nurse.

- 1. Do you have an active infection or fever?
- 2. Are you currently on antibiotics or within 7 days from completing antibiotic course?
- 3. Are you allergic to x-ray/contrast dye?
- 4. Have you had a flu, pneumonia or shingles vaccine in the last 14 days?
- 5. Are you currently taking prednisone (or any other steroids)?
- 6. Have you had a steroid injection within the last 14 days? (injection patients only)
- 7. Are you taking any **blood thinners/anticoagulants**?
